1. Log into the Parent Portal at https://smshs.sentral.com.au/portal

2. Interview bookings opened at 9am on Tuesday 17 June for Year 11. After that time, click on the yellow banner to open the PTI booking page.

3. The next window shows all classes in which a student is enrolled. Parents and carers can select times from the buttons on the right of screen. The sample student here shows all time slots filled.

4. When you click to set a time for each interview, the booking window looks like the image shown on the right.

Times that are greyed out are unavailable for a parent and carer, either because the teacher is unavailable or because they have a clashing time already booked.

Parents and carers can choose not required if they so desire.

Once all times have been selected, click on "Confirm Appointments", which should lock in your times.

Tips for Students from Cheryll, Our Careers Adviser

Dear Year 12 Students,

Thank you for attending the Year 12 Careers Expo. I do hope it is both informative and enjoyable.

Please see below the important points that must be adhered to:

- All of us will travel to and from the Expo on the chartered bus as this is the safest travel option for this busy event.
- Please report to the Student Car Park before 8:00 am so your name can be marked off and you can board your designated bus. Bus lists will be posted outside the library. Please note you are NOT able to switch buses.
- The buses will leave at 8.10 am from Kungala Street and Creek Road (opposite Ripples).
 - Please report to the teacher displaying the bus number you have been assigned.
 - You will receive your personalized entry wristband. This wristband is for entry into the Expo, and we cannot replace it so please wear it for the duration of the excursion.
- Please bring **only one small bag** that will safely store your valuables and you can always have them with you. You cannot leave any items on the bus.
- At the Expo, please approach all ambassadors respectfully and consider only collecting the information you require. Often students collect unnecessary paper resources, and these tend to become excess waste.
- There are food outlets available within the expo. They tend to have long queues and expensive prices.
 I would recommend you bring your own snacks and water for the day.
- To return to school, you must meet the teacher who marked your roll at school by 11.45 am outside the stadium for bus boarding.
- Your bus cannot leave the stadium until the roll has been marked, and all students are confirmed on the bus. Please ensure you are not late back to your bus, (the one you travelled down on).



- When you arrive back at school, you will be dismissed.
- Enjoy your day and please make the most of the opportunity to speak with the various ambassadors and collect relevant Information for your career pathways. Exhibitors include:

 - o organisations with apprenticeship information and opportunities

- 1. What can I study? Getting to know exactly what's on offer can help you narrow down your decision, or you might even hear about a course you hadn't considered before.
- 2. What are the entry requirements? ATAR/ subject bands or special entry requirements
- **3. Early Entry Options available and how to apply?** It's worth knowing if the course you're interested in has an early entry program so you can get your application in on time.
- 4. What do I do if I don't meet the entry requirements?
- **5.** Pathways or alternative ways of getting you into your course, including alternative pathways, bridging courses, adjustment factors, and more.
- 6. Where will my degree take me? Think about your passions and what you enjoy, as well as what you're good at do the careers your chosen degree leads to sound like something you'd enjoy and be good at?
- 7. Can I apply for a scholarship and how is that completed?
- 8. What other opportunities are available? There are many experiences on offer studying abroad, joining a club or society, or participating in an internship are just some of the other opportunities you might be able to access while at university.
