Principal's Report

It has been a very busy return from the winter holidays at St Marys Senior High School. We are still in the process of finalising our Year 11 2021 cohort. Once enrolment forms are returned we will then make a decision as to whether we are in a position to make any second round offers. We may also be making a small number of offers to students to take up a position in the current Year 11 cohort to commence at St Marys at the start of term four in the 2021 HSC class. The enrolment panel will meet later this term to consider expressions of interest for non-local enrolments following an audit of our enrolment numbers.

Traditionally a large number of events occur in Term 3, but the current restrictions may result in these events, either being cancelled or conducted in a very different format. The major events for this term generally include the examination period, Heritage Day, School Captain elections, Major Works Assembly and the Year 12 Graduation.

There has been some easing of restrictions in schools in Term 3 with the recommencement of interschool sport, VET work placements and essential external providers allowed on site. Excursions and camps however, remain on hold and parents and community members are still not permitted on school sites.



Be COVIDsafe in the exams

To help keep our community safe during our examinations, the following COVID-safe practices will be followed in all examinations

Step 1: Mask up



You might choose to wear a mask to the examinations.

As you get ready to come into the examination room, ensure you have your mask on

Step 2: Hands



When you enter the examination room, be sure to use the hand sanitiser provided

Step 3: Wipe down



At the end of the examination, wipe down your table and chair with the antibacterial wipes provided so they are ready for the next student

Step 4: Clean up



As you leave the venue, put all used wipes and tissues in the bin

EXAM RULES - SEMESTER 2 EXAMINATIONS

- A. All students should place their Student ID card face up on their examination table at the start of each examination.
- B. All Year 12 students are required to use their NESA number for these examinations.
- C. No computers, iPads, iPods/MP3 Players, iWatches etc can be taken into an exam venue. Students should not bring these to school on the day of their exams
- D. Bags will be permitted in exam venues. They must be placed in the area designated by the examination supervisors. Mobile phones must be switched off and left in your bag. If your phone rings during the examination, it will be removed from the examination room and given to the Principal or Deputy Principal. Students who do not comply with these rules will not be able to take their bags into the examination room. Any student found in the possession of a phone will be considered malpractice and a mark penalty of zero will apply.
- E. No hats/hoods to be worn (for ID purposes) or blankets to be taken into the exam room
- F. All watches are to be removed and placed on the right-hand-side of your desk
- G. If you wish to take **water** into the examination room, it **must be in a clear** bottle
- H. Pencil cases must be colourless and transparent.
- Students should bring several pens into the exam venue. They should be placed in a clear plastic sleeve or a colourless and transparent pencil case
- No tissue boxes can be taken into the exam rooms (supervisors will supply tissues if required)
- K. Students will not be permitted to leave an examination room early. All students will be required to remain in the examination room for the duration of their examination.

A reminder to head down to the Learning Centre if you need any extra help with course work or assessment tasks. Please see the roster provided below, showing which staff are scheduled on to help you and to organise the Peer Tutors available each lesson.
