We have been fortunate to find an interim operator for our cafeteria. The new provider is scheduled to start on 29 May 2023 and should be in place for twelve months whilst the full tender process proceeds. They look forward to hearing any feedback that will assist them to provide the best possible variety and service. I am certainly looking forward to the return of a barista on site.

We have had a number of questions regarding the mobile phone ban announced by the new New South Wales Government. The policy around this announcement is yet to be released and is currently in draft stage, with consultation occurring with stakeholder groups. Following the release of the policy we will be looking at developing procedures that align to the policy but also fit the expectations of a young adult learning environment.

We are currently in an academic reporting and feedback phase for Semester 1. Year 12 will be receiving their reports at the end of Week 4 via the Sentral Parent and Student Portal. Year 11 Semester 1 reports will be issued in the same manner at the end of Week 7. Parents and carers who have concerns about their child's progress beyond the academic reporting periods should contact their child's Student Adviser on 02 9623 8333. The names of the Student Advisers appear in this newsletter. Based on feedback from our last Student, Parent, Teacher Evening we have decided to keep the same format as last year for this evening. This will mean that it is conducted remotely rather than face to face. The feedback we received indicated that due to most of our students living outside of our very small drawing area, it was more convenient for parents and carers to have a phone discussion at a designated time rather than rushing from work or balancing the extracurricular activities of multiple children. Other feedback highlighted that the evening kept to designated times rather than interviews going over time. The Student, Parent, Teacher Evening for Year 12 will occur on the afternoon and evening of Tuesday 30 May 2023 and for Year 11 on Wednesday 21 June 2023. This newsletter will provide details on how to book interview times for each of the evenings.



Year 11 and 12 Student, Parent and Teacher Interviews

Our Year 11 and Year 12 Student, Parent and Teacher Interviews are taking shortly:

- Year 12 Student, Parent and Teacher interviews will take place on Tuesday 30 May between 4 pm and 8:30 pm.
- Year 11 Student, Parent and Teacher interviews will take place on Wednesday 21 June between 4 pm and 8:30 pm.

As a result of feedback on last year's interviews, teachers will undertake interviews via phone or Zoom, depending on each teacher's preference.

Bookings will be in 15 minute blocks which will give teachers time to have a 10 minute conversation with parents, caregivers and students, while also allowing for technical issues, dropouts or call failures.

Teachers will contact parents and caregivers by phone or Zoom teleconferencing to conduct interviews. Teachers will indicate which platform they will be using to students before the evening. Teachers who are using Zoom for interviews will provide the link needed to students prior to the interviews.

Teachers will call parents and carers on the phone number that we have on file, which parents and carers provided when students enrolled in the school. If you have changed your phone number since then, students can come to the office to collect a change of contact details form, or parents and carers can email their new contact details to the school email address, stmaryssen-h.school@det.nsw.edu.au.

The window for booking Year 12 interviews will be open from 9am on Monday 22 May until 7am on Monday 29 May 2023.

The window for booking Year 11 interviews will be open from 9am on Tuesday 13 June until 7am on Tuesday 20 June 2023.



How to book interview times with teachers

- 1. Log into the Parent Portal at https://smshs.sentral.com.au/portal
- 2. Interview bookings will open at 9am on Monday 22 May for Year 12 and Tuesday 13 June for Year 11. After that time, click on the yellow banner to open the PTI booking page.
- 3. The next window shows all classes in which a student is enrolled. Parents and carers can select times from the buttons on the right of screen. The sample student here shows all time slots filled.



4. When you click to set a time for each interview, the booking window looks like the image shown on the right.

Times that are greyed out are unavailable for a parent and carer, either because the teacher is unavailable or because they have a clashing time already booked.

Parents and carers can choose not required if they so desire.


Once all times have been selected, click on "Confirm Appointments", which should lock in your times.



5. When complete, you can choose to receive an email with times and dates as a calendar file.


