Year 11 Student, Parent and Teacher Interviews

Our Year 11 Student, Parent and Teacher Interviews will take place on Wednesday 21 June between 4 pm and 8:30 pm.

As a result of feedback on last year's interviews, teachers will undertake interviews via phone or Zoom, depending on each teacher's preference.

Bookings will be in 15 minute blocks which will give teachers time to have a 10 minute conversation with parents, caregivers and students, while also allowing for technical issues, dropouts or call failures.

Teachers will contact parents and caregivers by phone or Zoom teleconferencing to conduct interviews. Teachers will indicate which platform they will be using to students before the evening. Teachers who are using Zoom for interviews will provide the link needed to students prior to the interviews.

Teachers will call parents and carers on the phone number that we have on file, which parents and carers provided when students enrolled in the school. If you have changed your phone number since then, students can come to the office to collect a change of contact details form, or parents and carers can email their new contact details to the school email address, stmaryssen-h.school@det.nsw.edu.au.



How to book interview times with teachers

- 1. Log into the Parent Portal at https://smshs.sentral.com.au/portal
- 2. Interview bookings will open at 9am on Tuesday 13 June for Year 11. After that time, click on the yellow banner to open the PTI booking page.
- 3. The next window shows all classes in which a student is enrolled. Parents and carers can select times from the buttons on the right of screen. The sample student here shows all time slots filled.




4. When you click to set a time for each interview, the booking window looks like the image shown on the right.

Times that are greyed out are unavailable for a parent and carer, either because the teacher is unavailable or because they have a clashing time already booked.

Parents and carers can choose not required if they so desire.

Once all times have been selected, click on "Confirm Appointments", which should lock in your times.



5. When complete, you can choose to receive an email with times and dates as a calendar file.

Year 12 Careers Expo Excursion – Friday 23 June 2023

In the lead up to our trip to the Careers Expo, we have reminded our Year 12 students of the following points:

1. We encourage our students to use the QR code provided here to explore the fabulous opportunities available at the Expo to discover many study and career opportunities, to connect with all the tertiary education institutions and ask the important questions that will assist in post-school planning.



- 2. We will be travelling by bus from St Marys Senior High to Sydney Olympic Park and returning to school. Students must check the bus number they are travelling on from the list outside the library
- 3. Students need to be in full school dress code and meet in Kungala Street, near Ripples and the student car park gate by 8:00 am.
- 4. After getting their name marked off when getting on the bus, students will receive a wrist band for entry into the Expo. **Students must wear this and we cannot replace it**.
- 5. Students are only able to bring **a small bag** that will safely store their belongings which they are responsible for throughout the day. *No items will be able to be left on the bus.*
- 6. There are catering options available at the Stadium where students can buy refreshments, but the queues are long. Students are encouraged to bring water in a non-glass container and snacks.
- 7. Students must be the front of the Expo (drop off point) by 12.00 pm for a roll marking, bus boarding and return to school. Buses cannot leave until all students have been marked off on the roll, so students are reminded to be on time.


Year 12 students with any questions should see Cheryll (our Careers Adviser) or Lucas (our Head Teacher Secondary Studies) prior to the day.
