# **Principal's Report**

St Marys Senior High School has had a calendar packed full of activities over the last fortnight, and the final three weeks of Term 1 continue to be busy. Every weekend Leah posts on our social media platforms, the events of the week ahead to assist students and their families plan their week ahead. This helps us all plan our busy week. Please ensure you are following us on our socials to ensure you are up to date.

As Year 12 progress through their final year of schooling many students are looking at scholarships and early entry opportunities for universities. Many of these pathways require students to obtain recommendations from their school. At St Marys Senior High School, these recommendations are completed by the Principal. Staff are not able to complete written recommendations. At the end of the Topic Test Period, Year 12 students will receive an email which explains this process and includes the information that is required to be uploaded to support a written recommendation. It is imperative that students book in a time with me if they have any questions about this If students leave a request for a recommendation to the last minute, their

recommendation may be limited and not reflect the full extent of their skills and capabilities.

The Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS) through UAC can be submitted once opened by UAC. The recommendations for any SRS applications will be completed following the Trial Higher School Certificate Examinations.

#### **Topic Test Period**

Students have received the schedule for the Topic Test Period, to be held in Weeks 10 and 11 of this term (Monday 31 March – Wednesday 9 April 2025). We have also included it in this newsletter as a reminder to students and families. It is important that students confirm the details of the tasks with their class teachers well in advance of the task date.

During the Topic Test Period we will not be granting travel leave to students and it is expected that students will be present for their tasks on the published dates unless they are too unwell to attend school or there is a significant misadventure.

If a student is absent from a task due to illness and/or misadventure, they must follow the school's assessment policy when applying for illness and misadventure. This process is outlined in the assessment booklet issued to all students at the commencement of their course, with a key element involving the student emailing the Deputy Principal before 7.30 am on the morning of any task that is impacted by illness and/or misadventure.

Students will return to normal classes on Thursday 10 April, ensuring that students can follow up on any questions or concerns they have with their teachers before the Term 1 school holiday break.

#### **Financial Assistance**

At different times some of our families experience financial stress. Our prime objective at St Marys Senior High School is to support students in gaining a Higher School Certificate. If at any time a student may require additional support, please contact the Deputy Principal for Year 11, Danielle Ervine or the Deputy Principal for Year 12, Leah Havord. They will go over the options we have available to support our students to ensure their learning and wellbeing needs are met. If you have any queries regarding subject contributions, please contact our Relieving School Administration Manager, Angela Demaio.




# **School Sport Updates**


