# Principal's Report

Welcome back to Term 2! I hope you all enjoyed the holidays and were able to spend some time with your families and friends, as well as finding some time for a well-deserved break.

Our school athletics carnival is scheduled to be held in Term 2 during Week 6 on Monday 3 June. We are hoping that a strong school spirit is on display at the carnival, following the success of the swimming carnival. We have some outstanding athletes that I am looking forward to see compete, along with the range of Cluster colours.

Year 12 are now halfway through their final year of formal schooling – although that may sound scary, it is also very exiting with lots of new opportunities becoming available. The 2025 Higher School Certificate personalised written timetable will be published on Friday 2 May – Year 12 students should ensure that they have access to this timetable through their Students Online account. examination timetable will be released on Monday 28 April. For those students completing major works or performances as part of their studies, Term 2 should involve lots of planning to ensure that they meet due dates in the following term and produce a final product that highlights all of their effort, skills and talents. Students with multiple major works or performances were offered support by Surmeet, our Student Support Officer and have a number of opportunities to draw on the support provided by class teachers, Personal Mentors and Student Advisers. Students who are yet to draw on these supports are encouraged to make contact early this term.

Towards the end of Term 1, I sent Year 12 students an email explaining the school's processes in relation to early entry requirements for university and UAC Student Recommendation Scheme (SRS) applications. These processes will ensure that we can support students meet these deadlines and provide supporting documentation where needed. Students are encouraged to book an appointment with Cheryll, our Careers Adviser to assist with planning their pathways beyond school. This can be done in person in the school library or via the online booking system provided by Cheryll (the link to which can be found in the year group Google Classroom).

Some Year 12 students who have experienced significant disadvantage which they believe have impacted on their studies may consider putting in an application under the Educational Access Scheme through UAC. There are a variety of categories that fall under the EAS Scheme, and I encourage students to use the following link to find further information (<u>https://www.uac.edu.au/future-applicants/scholarships-and-schemes/educational-access-schemes/how-to-apply</u>) or book in a time with Cheryll to discuss particular circumstances.

Congratulations to Year 11 for completing their first term at St Marys Senior High School. We hope that you have settled in well, have a better understanding of our processes, made some new friends and participated in a range of extra-curricular activities to broaden your experiences. As you work your way through this important year, we encourage you to take full advantage of the opportunities available to you. In particular we hope you have actively participated in those extra-curricular activities that interest you, whether they involve sports, music, clubs or community service. Engaging in these activities not only helps to broaden your experiences but also strengthens your skills, fosters teamwork, and enhances your overall enjoyment of school life. As we commence Term 2, we encourage you to continue exploring your interests and setting personal goals. Remember, your teachers and staff are here to support you. We look forward to seeing your growth and achievements in the upcoming terms.
