What should I be able to do at the end of the course?

Through a study of Business Studies, students will develop knowledge and understanding regarding each of the following:

- The effectiveness of different management strategies.
- The importance of responsible participation in business activity and ethical business behaviour, as well as the social responsibility of business.

Students will also develop a wide range of skills, including the ability to:

- Investigate, synthesise and evaluate contemporary business issues in hypothetical and actual business situations.
- Communicate business information using appropriate formats.
- Apply mathematical concepts appropriate to business situations.

How will this course help me in the future?

The study of Business Studies will provide students with knowledge, understanding and skills that form a valuable foundation for a range of courses at tertiary institutions. Students who would particularly benefit from studying this course include those who are planning to undertake further studies in the areas of accounting, advertising, business management, financial management, human resource management and marketing, as well as those students planning to become self-employed.
